Code of Conduct and Behaviour

Federation of Broomball Associations of Ontario members and participants will conduct themselves in manners of fairness, integrity and mutual respect, values of the FBAO, at all times. This policy is expected of all FBAO participants and members, includes Players, Parents, Guardians, Coaches, Teams Officials, Major & Minor Officials, Volunteers, Representatives, Directors and Executive.

This standard of behaviour by all, will provide behaviour and an environment of respect of and to all individuals. FBAO members will avoid behaviour that brings disrepute onto the sport of broomball or the FBAO.

Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring & Civility are aspects of character development and conduct thereof FBAO members and participants.

Participants and members will abide by the Constitution and By-laws of the FBAO and it's policies and procedures and to the rules and regulations of the game.

FBAO activities' and competitions should demonstrate standards of ethics and sportsmanship at all times.

Members will not participate, comment or behave in manners that constitute bullying, harassment or abuse or which endangers the safety of others.

The failure of FBAO members and participants to comply with the Code of Conduct & Behaviour could result in disciplinary action(s) by the appropriate level(s) of the FBAO.

The FBAO Code of Conduct & Behaviour identifies character that is expected of all FBAO members. The FBAO is committed to maintaining an environment of respect.

Parents

I will support my child's decision to play their desired sport. I will not force them to participate.

I will respect that children are involved in sports for fun and enjoyment.

I will encourage my child to play by and respect the rules of the game and exhibit sportsmanship at all times.

I will demonstrate a positive attitude towards the games and its participants. The positive example you display will benefit your child, children learn by example.

I will applaud and offer praise for good effort and enforce the positives of the game.

I will never yell at, ridicule or abuse players, opponents, fans, coaches or officials.

I will respect, recognize and appreciate the importance of volunteer coaches.

Players

I will play broomball for fun. I will play because I want to.

I will be a true team player, learn teamwork, sportsmanship and discipline

I will work hard to improve my skills and give 100% effort at each practice and game.

I will learn the rules of the game, to play & abide by the spirit of them.

I will respect my teammates, my coach, my parents, my opponents and the officials.

Coaches

I will make the game fun and remember players are involved in the sport for enjoyment

I will mind the child/player more than winning the game.

I will be a positive role model, show sportsmanship, players learn by example.

I will assert an open & positive line of communication with players and parents.

I will show respect for minor and major officials.

I will be honest, consistent and generous with praise.
